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INTRODUCTION

"genialsozial" is neutral and non-partisan and aims to help to permanently and sustainably reduce worldwide differences in socio-economic development and general living conditions, and is committed to the attainment of human rights and the preservation of natural resources. The main decision-making body consists of students from the Free State of Saxony.

All social and charitable associations, initiatives and/or organisations are admitted as applicants if their statutes state a declared goal of development cooperation based on partnership and if they are recognised as non-profit organisations. The registered office must be located in Saxony, Saxony-Anhalt, Thuringia or Brandenburg; or in the case of a federal structure with corresponding professional associations in Saxony, Saxony-Anhalt, Thuringia or Brandenburg.
